Due to security concerns, the only way to do this is to update the password directly in the database. You will need to have access to run SQL statements in the database in order to do this.

Run this statement:

```
UPDATE OPS_User SET password =  
'-4851-3042-2972-82-7510215-622010-2053-1231277-87-105' WHERE login = 'XYZ'
```

(replace XYZ with your login name)

This statement will change your password to "admin". We recommend to change it once you have logged in.

It is also recommended to make a database backup before you make these manual changes.
